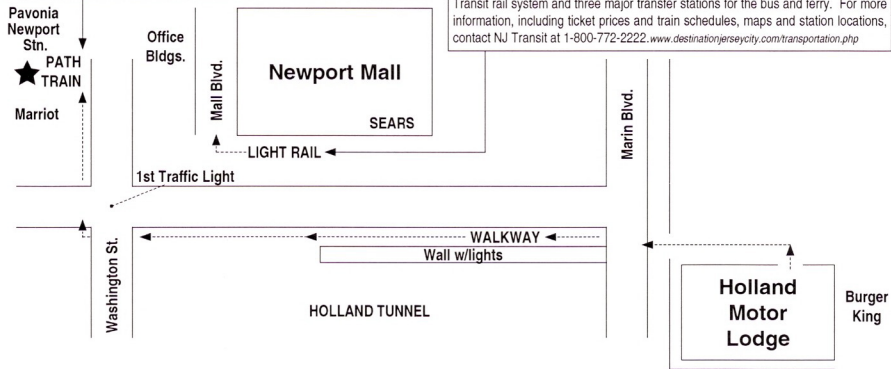


## Directions to Path Train (Pavonia/Newport Station)

The Port Authority Trans-Hudson (**PATH**) subway system provides a quick and easy way to get to directly to midtown or downtown Manhattan—no transfers required. Trains run 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 4 conveniently located stations throughout Jersey City: Exchange Place, Grove Street, Pavonia/Newport and Journal Square. The Hudson-Bergen **Light Rail** system connects the western portions of Jersey City to Exchange Place, Newport Center, Hoboken Terminal and residential Bayonne. You can also make an easy connection to PATH subway trains to midtown and lower Manhattan. With more than a dozen stations throughout the city, these streamlined trains provide an important link between Jersey City's neighborhoods and the surrounding region. The light rail line is also connected to the rest of the NJ Transit rail system and three major transfer stations for the bus and ferry.
